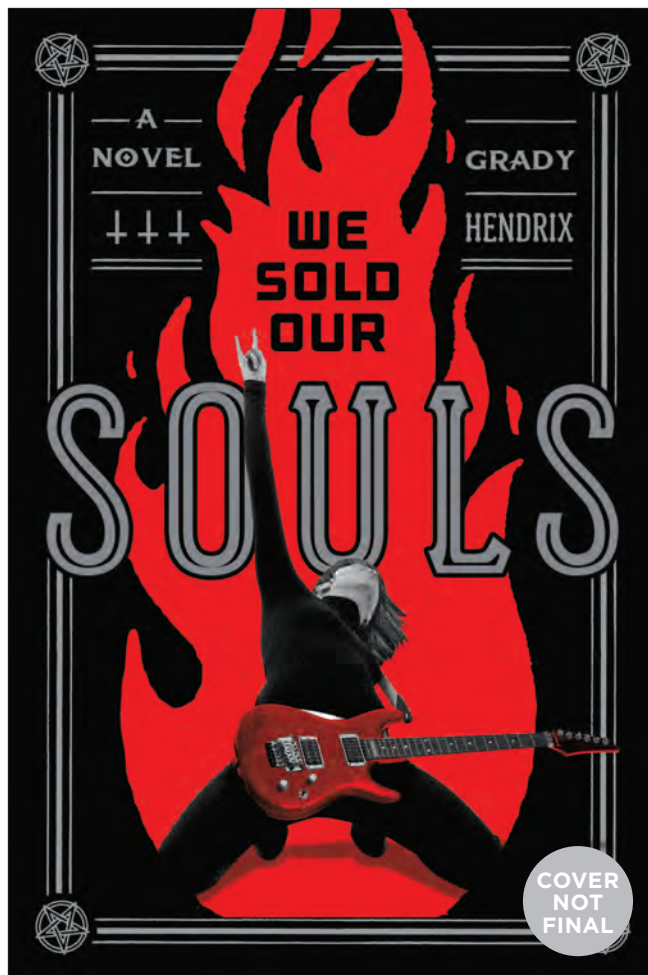

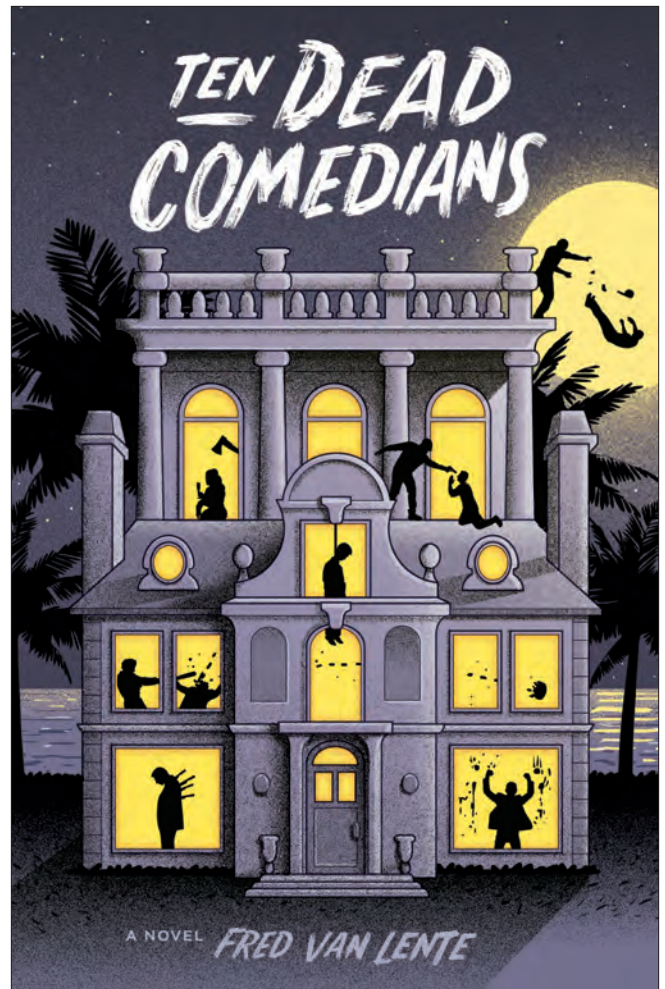

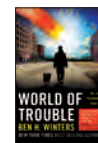

Grab some popcorn and take a seat . . . The curtain is about to rise on a film like no other! But first, the real-life backstory: *Giraffes on Horseback Salad* was a Marx Brothers film written by modern art icon Salvador Dalí, who'd befriended Harpo. With the help of Groucho and Chico, Jimmy seeks to join her fantastical world—but forces of normalcy threaten to end their romance. 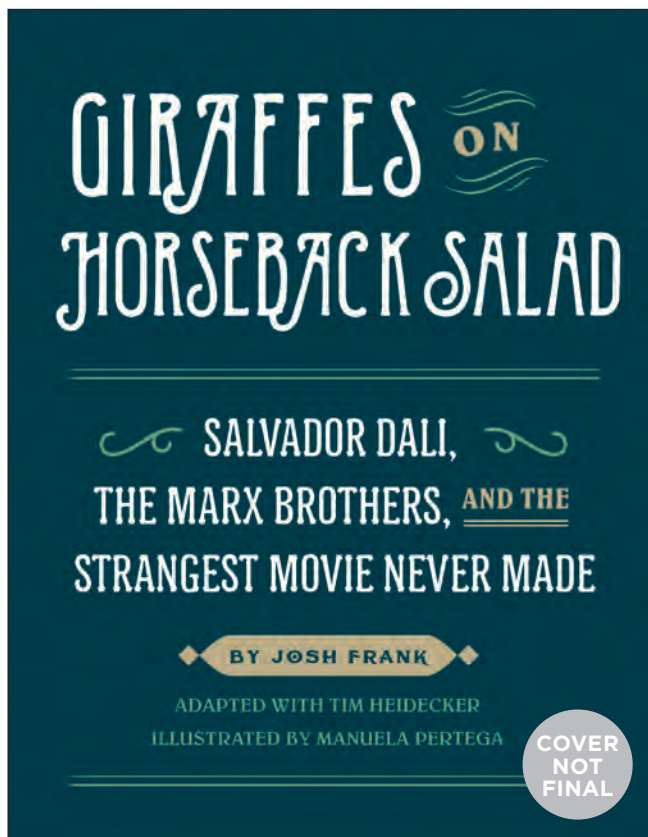

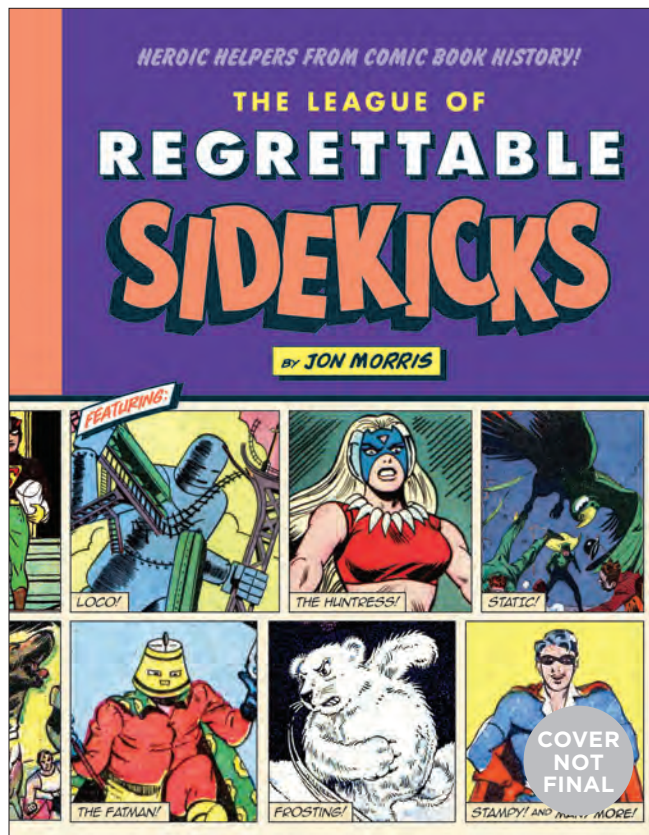
Batman has Robin. Captain America has Bucky. And Yankee Doodle has Dandy. Being a superhero is hard work, which is why so many comics characters rely on a sidekick—someone to watch the hero's back, help the hero search for clues, or, if nothing else, give the hero somebody to talk to. But not every superhero achieves the glory of Batman, and not all sidekicks are as capable as the Boy Wonder.

In *The League of Regrettable Sidekicks*, author Jon Morris shines a hilarious spotlight on forgotten helpers like Thunderfoot (explosive-soled assistant to the Human Bomb), super-pets (like Frosting, polar bear pal of space hero Norge Benson), fan favorites (Rick Jones, sidekick to half of the Marvel Universe), and obscure partners of iconic heroes (Superman Junior's career barely got off the ground). Included are pernicious profiles of henchmen and minions, the sidekicks of the supervillain world. Vintage comics art completes the experience.

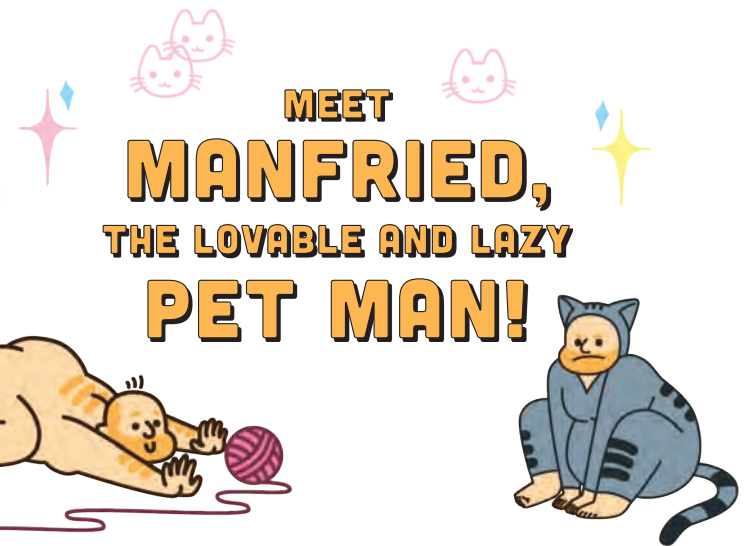
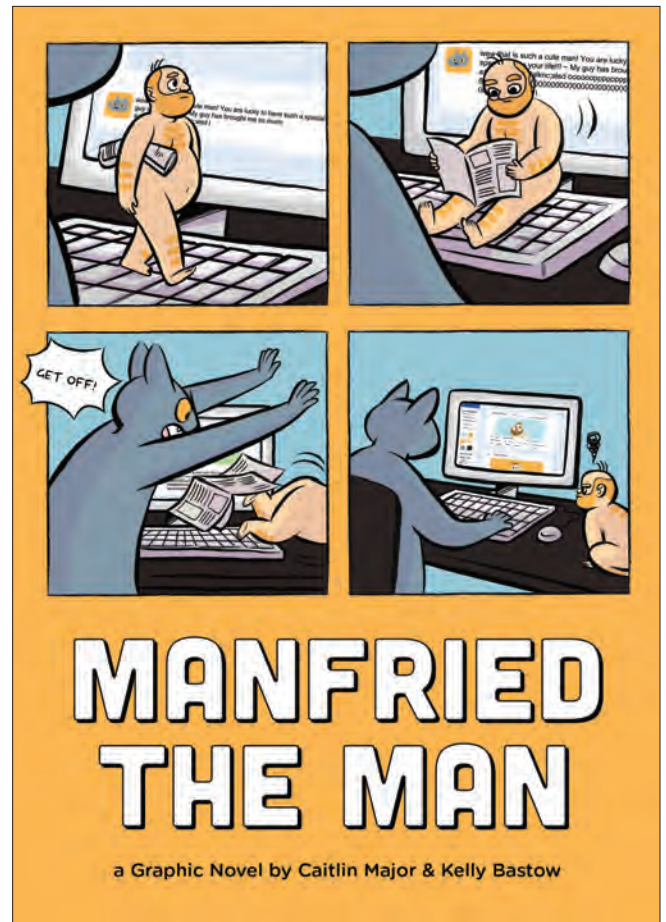

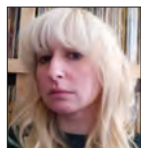

Every twenty- or thirty-something woman knows these books. The pink covers, the flimsy paper, the zillion volumes in the series that kept you reading for your entire adolescence. In six hilarious chapters (Friendship, Love, School, Family, Jobs, Terror, and Tragedy), *Bustle* features editor Gabrielle Moss takes the reader on a nostalgic tour of teen book covers of yore, digging deep into the history of the genre as well as the stories behind the best-known series.

Spurred by the commercial success of *Sweet Valley High* and the *Babysitters Club*, these paperbacks were cheap, short, and utterly beloved. *Paperback Crush* revisits this golden age with affection and just a little snark. Readers will discover (and fondly remember) girl-centric series on everything from correspondence (*Pen Pals* and *Dear Diary*) to sports (*Cheerleaders* and *The Gymnasts*) to a newspaper at an all-girls Orthodox Jewish middle school (*The B.Y. Times*) to a literal teen angel (*Teen Angels: Heaven Can Wait*). Some were blatant rip-offs of successful series (*Sleepover Friends*), some were sick-lit tear-jerkers (*Abby, My Love*), and some were just plain perplexing (*Uncle Vampire?*). But all of them represent that time gone by of girl power and sustained silent reading.
