Dystopia, 12+: THE SHELL COLLECTOR. YOUR DESTINY IS WAITING by Charlotte Richter (ISBN 60435, 432 p.)

Mariel had always expected to be happy on the island of Amlon with its pearl-white beaches and the turquoise sea. But deep-down Mariel feels that she does not belong. While her friends enjoy life in paradise, she feels drawn to anything that is less than perfect. Like her beloved shells with their cracks, and Sander, the boy who gives her the first kiss. But she can never be together with him, because one of the rules in Amlon is that you can only find happiness with your ideal partner, and whoever rebels against this rule will be banned forever!

Nature, 4+: ANIMALS IN THE WILD. THE LITTLE BEECH TREE AND HER FRIENDS (VOL. 18) by Friederun Reichenstetter, illustrated by Hans-Günther Döring (ISBN 71514, 40 pages)

The forest smells so good! No wonder that people and animals feel happy there. But why is the forest air so good? And why is the forest so important for us? The forest ecosystem is explained for children aged 4 and above using the example of a little beech tree. The beech's leaf canopy offers protection for forest animals and provides fresh air for everyone. But the beech also depends upon the forest community. When it gets infested with aphids, it is helped by the ladybird. When there's an autumn storm raging, the trees all help protect one another. And when the beech is deprived of sunlight, a nearby mother-beech provides it with food. An insight into the wonderful harmony of the forest – with audio-CD.

He deserts the army and finds a new home in Ulm. As scribe to the city council he witnesses something no one dared hope for: the peace treaties of 1648.
