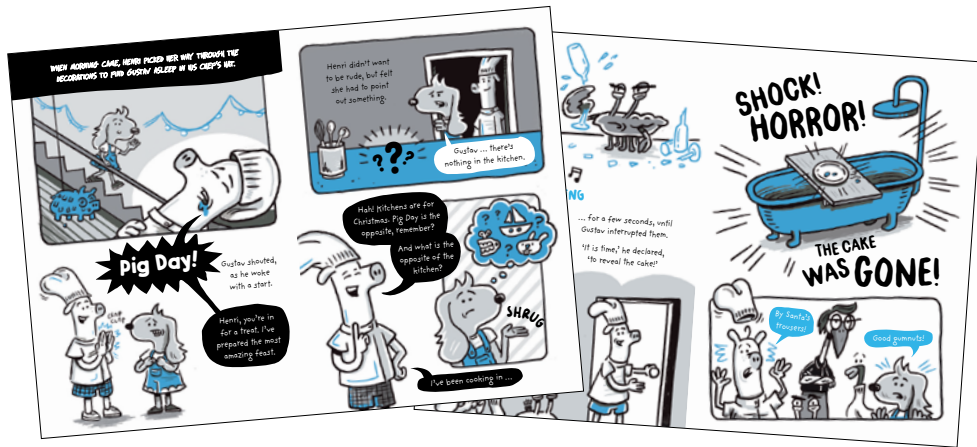


Opposites attract in this humorous graphic novel series about best friends Gustav and Henri.
