# The Ampersand Prize 10 Year Anniversary



The Ampersand Prize will celebrate its tenth anniversary this year, following a decade of exceptional publishing and bringing fresh voices to the world.

Established by Hardie Grant Children's Publishing, the prize has quickly become Australia and New Zealand's premier award for unpublished writers of middle-grade and young adult fiction. The Ampersand Prize has launched the careers of numerous best-selling and critically acclaimed authors including Melissa Keil (*Life in Outer Space*), Erin Gough (*The Flywheel*), Cally Black (*In The Dark Spaces*), Rhiannon Williams (*Ottile Colter and the Narrowway Hunt*)

and Lisa Siberry (*The Brilliant Ideas of Lily Green*). Across the globe, Ampersand Prize winning authors have gone on to work with such houses as Little Brown (USA), Editions Nathan (France), cbj Verlag (Germany) and VR Editoras (Spain).

The most recent winner, H.S. Valley, published her winning young adult novel, *Tim Te Maro and the Subterranean Heartsick Blues*, in August 2020. HGCP will celebrate this milestone anniversary with the publication of two additional shortlisted titles and new works from previous winners, plus a commemorative party which will award this year's winning manuscript.
