MAKE YOUR OWN LIST

What's Your Grief? (Your List of Losses)

The loss of something meaningful isn't just one earth-shattering loss. It is an immense loss, followed by a series of smaller losses in its aftermath. This domino effect of subsequent losses is known as *secondary loss*.

When you consider the impact of death, divorce, trauma, illness, and other significant losses, the inevitability of accompanying losses seems obvious. Yet, grieving people are often caught off guard by these ongoing losses and how they compound grief. Each individual loss is unique and complex in its own right. Add them together, and they give intimidating new meaning to the expression "The whole is greater than the sum of its parts."

Secondary losses are also seldom formally acknowledged by supportive friends, family, and community members. We've yet to see a sympathy card that reads, "I am so sorry to hear you've lost faith in your fundamental belief system." Or, "My most heartfelt sympathies regarding the loss of half of your household income."

Sure, those cards sound absurd, but therein lies the problem. Secondary losses are often so personal and private that it's difficult to give and receive support for them. Though we can't list your secondary losses for you, knowing these four categories can help you create your personal inventory.

Concrete Secondary Losses

Examples: losing a home, business, important objects, or finances

Relational Secondary Losses

Examples: losing friends who weren't supportive,

losing family due to conflict, losing community as a result of a move

Belief System Secondary Losses

Examples: loss of hopes and dreams for the future, loss of a belief in a higher power, loss of faith in a fair, just, or safe world

Identity Secondary Losses

Examples: loss of role as a spouse or caregiver, loss of self-confidence, loss of career identity upon retirement, loss of physical or cognitive ability, independence, or autonomy

We recommend you take time to assess your own secondary losses. Sometimes, seeing all these losses written down can provide a visual for just how complex the experience of grief actually is. In a practical sense, this exercise also helps you conceptualize what you need help coping with.

So here's what we want you to do:

- Grab a sheet of paper or your journal.
- Write down your primary loss (or losses).
- Next, write down the secondary losses that were associated with the primary loss(es).
- If there are losses associated with these secondary losses, write those down too.
- As you're writing, notice if you hesitate to include secondary losses that seem less significant or disruptive. Push back on yourself. This exercise is to help you reflect on the full impact of your grief, so you must include all your secondary losses—big and small.

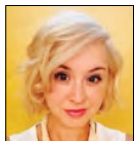
This celebration of notable magical women, from the Salem witch trials to WitchTok, is a fascinating read for anyone interested in occultism or feminist history.

And more mystical women from American history who found strength through the supernatural—and who are still forging the way today.

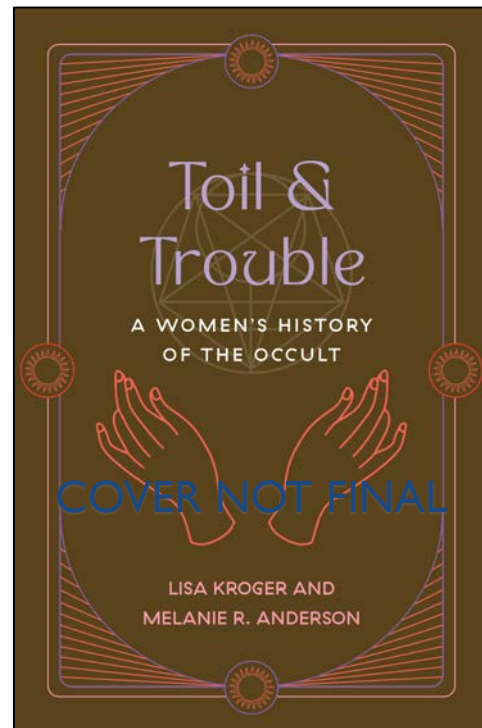
