Chronicles aboard the SOS Mediterranée ship, recounted by its founder.

Alessandro Porro had a normal life until, a few years ago, he came across a picture of an African baby rescued from the waters of the Mediterranean Sea during a journey of hope to Europe. From that moment on, Alessandro's life changed: after founding an international NGO, he and his team patrol the seas south of Sicily looking for boats in trouble and migrants searching for rescue.

ALESSANDRO PORRO worked as a computer scientist after getting his degree in Turin. In 2017, he joined SOS Mediterranée, an NGO dedicated to rescuing shipwrecked people in the Sicily Channel. He is now president of the organization and lives part of the year doing rescue missions on the ship and others "at rest" near Siena

MARCO MAGNONE is an author of children's books. He teaches at the Holden School in Turin, is a member of the Mare di Libri festival and collaborates on several reading education projects.





Ardito is thirteen and has one main dream: to become a famous soccer player and end up on a sticker. That's why, after he breaks a window at school with a soccer ball and his parents punish him by banning him from playing soccer, he is willing to do anything to make it up to them. Specifically, he has to get a 10+, the highest grade his Italian teacher has ever given in his career, in an essay about a grandparent. Too bad Grandma Emma is always too busy to see him and Grandpa Marzio spends his time in a wheelchair or in bed, drooling rather than eating, babbling rather than talking about a non-existent diamond. For more than 30 years, hundreds of files were buried in a padlocked wardrobe with its doors turned to face the wall. It held stories that people wanted to forget: the stories of Nazi-Fascist massacres during the German Occupation from 1943 to 1945 that bloodied Italy. When the Wardrobe of Shame was finally opened, descriptions of crimes, names of alleged perpetrators, witnesses, photographs, maps, and interrogations came into the light: everything necessary, to start an investigation and bring a trial. The judge who initiated those investigations, Marco De Paolis, tells how he prepared a case to find the perpetrators of those massacres. The story of a life carried out facing pitfalls and dangers, with the courage and sense of justice of one who knows his duty: that of giving answers to the survivors and descendants of the victims, to those who suffered the greatest injustices of all.

MARCO DE PAOLIS is a military prosecutor general at the Court of Appeal in Rome. He dedicated his life to investigating Nazi-Fascist massacres, instructing 17 trials and leading to the conviction of dozens of war criminals. In 2021 he received the Order of Merit, a prestigious honor bestowed on him by the Federal Republic of Germany.

ANNALISA STRADA is a children's book author and a secondary school humanities teacher. She has won numerous awards, including the Andersen Prize, the Giant of the Langhe, the Cento Prize, the Arpino Prize, and the Selezione Bancarellino.

She wrote about her escape and the time spent in Switzerland in pages of a diary that she still has at her home in Milan. Together with her husband, who is also Jewish, she has brought her testimony to many schools in Italy.
