We acquire two sister companies: Edizioni Sonda, whose main themes are ethical diets, civil rights, social inclusion, environmental responsibility; and Tunué, whose focus is graphic novels for junior and adult readers.

Il Castoro is **the leading independent children's book publisher in Italy** with a catalogue of over **800 children's books** and an average of **870,000 copies sold per year**. Our books have been translated into **39 languages** and... we can't wait to see what's next!




THE CURSED GAME
