# Tim Flannery and Emma Flannery



**Professor Tim Flannery** is one of the world's leading scientists, explorers and conservationists. He's spent most of his life studying the natural world – from mammalogy to palaeontology – and has had some incredible adventures along the way, including floating down crocodile-infested rivers and wrestling pythons. He's discovered 75 new species of animals – some that are still living, and others that have been preserved as fossils. 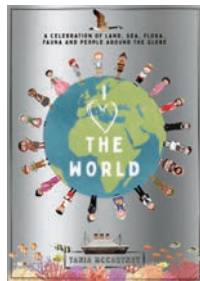

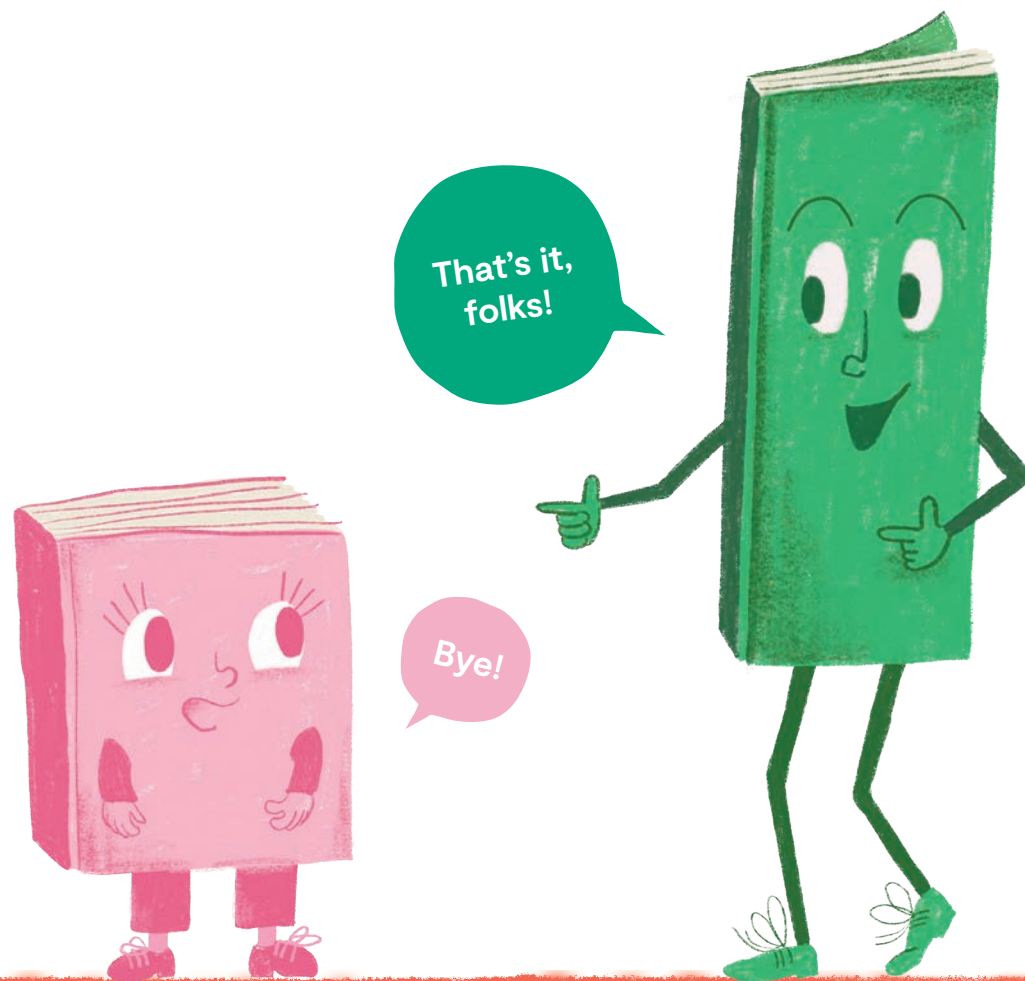
