
In this stunning debut by a South Carolina attorney, Zach Stander, a lawyer with a past, and Addie Stone, his indomitable detective and lover, find themselves entangled in secrets, lies, and murder in a small Southern town.

A high-profile murder case—A white woman has been bludgeoned to death with an altar cross in a rural church on Cicada Road in Walterboro, South Carolina. Sam Jenkins, a Black man, is found covered in blood, kneeling over the body. In a state already roiling with racial tension, this is not only a murder case, but a powder keg.

A haunting cold case—Two young women are murdered on quiet Edisto Beach, an hour southeast of Walterboro, and the killer disappears without a trace. Thirty-four years later the mystery remains unsolved. Could there be a connection to Stander's case?

A killer who's watching—Stander takes on Jenkins's defense, but he's up against a formidable solicitor with powerful allies. Worse, his client is hiding a bombshell secret. When Addie Stone reopens the cold case, she discovers more long-buried secrets in this small town. Would someone kill again to keep them?

- SOUTHERN GOTHIC STORIES ARE HOT: The recently tried Murdaugh murders case—which also involves a dynasty of corrupt lawyers running the solicitor/prosecutor's office in a small town for nearly a century—has fueled interest in Lowcountry crime stories, and this book is set in the same town.
- KNOWLEDGEABLE AUTHOR: Cleveland's background as an attorney in South Carolina and her knowledge of the details and environs make her the ideal writer for this story.
- A DEBUT WITH SERIES POTENTIAL: The main characters could easily move into another novel; the author's legal work in Charleston has given her access to great material that can keep books coming for years to come.



Kelly Dwyer, a graduate of the Iowa Writer's Workshop, published two literary novels back in the '90s: *The Tracks of Angels* and *Self Portrait with Ghosts*. She's also written plays that have been produced in New York; Boston; Madison, Wisconsin; and Glasgow, Scotland.

Ghost Mother is a mesmerizing psychological ghost story that blurs the thin line between reality and delusion.

Lilly Bly desperately wants to have a baby. She is struggling with infertility and bad spending habits when her husband, Jack, gets a new job that moves them from Chicago to a small town in Wisconsin. Impractical Lilly falls in love with a decrepit mansion well out of their price range—she is convinced that she will finally get pregnant and have a baby in this house—and Jack reluctantly agrees to buy the wreck. But when Lilly learns that her dream house was the site of a gruesome triple homicide/suicide in the 1950s, she begins to experience strange occurrences that soon lead her to believe the house is haunted. Are her ghostly encounters real, or is this a cascading mental breakdown? As Lilly learns more about the deaths and her visions become increasingly vivid, her relationship with Jack deteriorates, leading to a dramatic and irreversible climax.

- RISING AUTHOR: Although Kelly Dwyer has published two literary novels in the past, this is her debut in the world of psychological horror.
- POPULAR CATEGORY: Ghost stories are perennially popular, and Ghost Mother will appeal to fans of bestselling authors like Stephen King, Paul Tremblay, and M. R. James.
- GREAT STORYTELLING: This is a chillingly paced ghost story in the spirit of Henry James's The *Turn of the Screw* and Shirley Jackson's *The Haunting of Hill House* (adapted as a hit series on Netflix) with elements of noir murder mystery.
