
Illustrator from Barcelona.

sources of inspiration for her work.










Eliana Gutiérrez:

She currently lives in Madrid.




























Laia Albareda:











Maria Gargot:























Maria Guitart:



















































Quim Torres:























Toni Galmés:


Vanessa Linares:
