
What if you couldn't afford the word "freedom"?






A book with great poetic and metaphorical strength written and illustrated by Ester Armanino about how we can learn to live with a great pain.



Mare is sweet, caring, in love with her to the point that he fears losing her. Sometimes he checks her mobile phone, partly in jest, partly out of jealousy. Or he asks her to change her clothes, so as not to attract too much attention. Eli accepts because she loves him. Jealousy of the is part of love. Or is it? Cristian is the opposite of Eli. As children they were friends, but now they don't even look at each other. Cristian is closed off, he finds it hard to open up to others, is mocked by his schoolmates, he is mistrustful of his foster parents. On the bike, however, he is great: he is the strongest cyclist in GS Ombregno. Eli and Cristian find each other thanks to Mike, a coach with a special charisma. Mike is a born fighter, his opponent are injustices. Like the homophobic ones in which he will be sucked into, amid threats, abuse and the most unspeakable ferocity.

MARCO ERBA is a much-loved children's author. He has been teaching literature in a Milan high-school for ten years. As a journalist he has worked on local news stories. His debut novel Between me and you (sold 12,000 copies) won the Galdus prize and the City of Cuneo prize in the schools category.

RANDA GHAZY

Six stories of women from the Arab world who gave rise to change.

Doria Shakif, Egyptian, led women in her country to fight for the vote. Shireen Abu Akleh, Palestinian, gave her life to tell the world about the reality of the Israeli occupation of the Palestinian territories. Georgina Rizk, Lebanese, the first Miss Universe of Arab origin, spread a transversal message of sexual liberation and challenging customs. Djamila Bouherid, Algerian, rose up against French colonial occupation. Haifa Zangana, Iraqi, opposed Saddam Hussein's regime. Tawakkol Karman, Yemeni, was the first woman in the Arab world to be awarded the Nobel Peace Prize. These are the six revolutionaries whose stories Randa Ghazy has chosen to tell through her writing, which is well-documented, passionate and implacable. Alongside many others, these heroines, burdened by the yoke of patriarchy and social, economic and gender disparity, used their own courage and determination to conquer the only thing that counts for all women the world over: freedom.

RANDA GHAZY (1986) was born in Saronno to Egyptian parents. At just 15 she published her first book (Sognando Palestina, Fabbri 2002), which was followed by Prova a sanguinare. Quattro ragazzi, un treno, la vita (Fabbri, 2005) and Oggi forse non ammazzo nessuno. Storie minime di una giovane musulmana stranamente non terrorista (Rizzoli, 2016). She lives in London, where she works as a journalist and as media manager for an NGO.



Fabrizio Gatti returns to fiction to tell this powerful story, witnessed by the author himself. A unique look at war, borders and the struggles of refugees.


On October 11, 2013 near Lampedusa, a refugee boat sank. They called it the children's shipwreck. A massacre without culprits, but many to blame. Fabrizio Gatti, the celebrated Italian investigative reporter and correspondent, was on the island when it happened. From that moment, he would not stop until those who didn't want to see, those who didn't want to intervene, took responsibility for the death of 268 Syrian citizens, over a hundred of whom were children. Today, Fabrizio delicately recounts the story for young readers, in the form of a novel told in first person, a unique and heartbreaking voice that tells the truth of that story and together gives voice to all the people fleeing their country's war: from Syrians to Libyans to Ukrainians.

FABRIZIO GATTI is an author and one of Italy's most well-known journalists. His investigative reporting along the illegal immigration routes from Africa into Europe, and in *caporalato* slave labor in farming and construction have been translated across the globe and has been awarded important international prizes. *Viki Who Wanted to Go to School* sold over 50,000 copies his investigative narrative nonfiction *Bilal: Traveling, Working, and Dying as Undocumented Immigrants* sold 40,000 copies and is in production to be an eight-part miniseries on Sky.
