

## HOPE NEVER LETS YOU DOWN Pilgrims towards a better world Pope Francis

In this new book, written especially for the 2025 Jubilee – declared under the watchword «Pilgrims of Hope» – Pope Francis offers vital insights for the Holy Year beginning on 24 December 2024. The Holy Father offers his readers his vision of hope, as well as recounting the role of hope in both his and his predecessors' magisterium, in literature and, more broadly, in the history of humanity. In introducing a Jubilee for a world growing more and more complex, Pope Francis analyses the major issues of our times through an array of «figures» providing a glimmer of hope. An expectant mother introduces the issues of families, natality, and the Church; an indigent man opens a discussion on the social, political, and economic situation at a global level; a refugee offers the opportunity to reflect on migrations and geopolitics, and a civilian in a war zone to speak of the hope for peace; the figures of a senior and a preteen together epitomize the opportunities and shared challenges we must face. In conclusion, the Pope points to concrete actions in order to build, through hope, a better world while confronting the great challenges of the future, such as the development of artificial intelligence and the consequences of climate change.

The Holy Year is the fulfilment of a strong wish of the Pope and will represent a turning point for the Church and beyond.

Hernán Reyes Alcaide (Buenos Aires, 1983) is a journalist and communications consultant, and Vatican correspondent for *Religión Digital*. He has traveled with the Pope to more than 20 countries and published in Télam (Argentina), El Observador (Uruguay), L'Osservatore Romano (Vatican City), among other media. In 2017 he co-wrote Latinoamérica with Pope Francis. In 2023 he was declared Outstanding Cultural Personality of the City of Buenos Aires. In 2022 he edited Pope Francis' book *I Ask You in the Name of God* (Piemme).


From Christmas 2024 to Epiphany 2026, the Jubilee that periodically commemorates the birth of Jesus Christ will take place in Rome. This 30th Holy will have the motto 'Pilgrims of Hope'. Pope Francis called it "a special gift of grace, characterised by the forgiveness of sins and, in particular, by indulgence, the full expression of God's mercy", in continuity with the Jubilee of Mercy, which he had celebrated between 2015 and 2016. Saverio Gaeta's book will be the most comprehensive guide to fully experience this unique event. The author will explain the meaning of the Holy Year, focusing on the historical and spiritual meaning of the Jubilee and describing its symbols for 2025: pilgrimage, penitential acts, special rites and modalities, official prayer, hymn and logo. He will also present the programme of the Jubilee events planned in Rome and recount anecdotes and curiosities from past Jubilees. Finally, he will take readers on a journey to the places of the Jubilee, illustrating the papal basilicas of Rome (St. Peter's, St. John Lateran, St. Mary Major, St. Paul Outside the Walls) and the three other basilicas (Santa Croce in Gerusalemme, St. Lawrence Outside the Walls, St. Sebastian) that make up the itinerary of the 'Seven Churches' of St. Philip Neri. Completing the manual are maps of the most important places and a section of essential information for pilgrims and visitors, with useful numbers and addresses and instructions on how to getting around the city.

Journalist, essayist and Vaticanist Saverio Gaeta is the author of a hundred books and essays. He has published the bestseller *Il Veggente* with Salani in 2016 and, with Piemme, *La profezia dei due papi* in 2018 and *Nient'altro che la verità* with Georg Gänswein in 2023, which has become a real publishing case with more than 30,000 copies sold.

## BENEDICT XVI The theologian, the pope, the man Andrea Tornielli

The passing of Benedict XVI on December 31, 2022, opened a wound in the Vatican, upending already fragile balances and exacerbating the clash between the supporters of Pope Francis and the more conservative wing of the clergy. Andrea Tornielli retraces the life of the Pope Emeritus, from his childhood in Germany to his studies in theology, from his first steps in the Vatican alongside John Paul II to his election to the papacy and his resignation. The author explores the lights and shadows of a man accused by many of hyper-conservativism, labeled a «strict and inflexible inquisitor», overshadowed by scandals such as the Vatileaks and the sexual abuse cases. And yet, if we make the effort to go beyond cliches and resist the temptation to settle for slogans, we discover a different Ratzinger – a man who was attentive to the protection of the environment, of peace, of the poor and marginalized.

This book is the exhaustive and deeply researched portrait of a man of simple habits, a lover of books and music and a great theologian, and the story of a seven-year papacy the author – a Vatican correspondent – was able to follow closely and first-hand: the encyclicals, the official visits around the world, the major decisions, the encounters. An authoritative document revealing a man who undoubtedly changed forever the history of the Vatican.

Andrea Tornielli is manager of the editorial department of the Dicastery for Communication of the Holy Seat. Previously he was a Vaticanist and special correspondent for several newspapers, and coordinator of the web site Vatican Insider. His many books include the biographies of Pope Pius XII (2007) and Pope Paul VI (2009), and the best-sellers II nome di Dio è misericordia. [The name of God is Mercy] (2016), Dov'è Dio? Una conversazione con Julián Carrón [Where is God? A conversation with Julián Carrón] (2017) and Vita di Gesù [The life of Jesus] (2022), all published by Piemme.





What makes unique the saint who took «Lady Poverty» as his bride, and why is he still one of the most venerated figures not just in the Church but in the history of humanity? These and many more are the questions explored by Roberto Repole, archbishop of Turin, in this new book - not the umpteenth biography or collection of anecdotes on the life of the saint from Assisi, but a truly innovative and enlightening portrait. Saint Francis' vow of poverty, his love for all living creatures, his poetry, are already well known. The aim of the author is to shed light on a less known side of Francis, and the real reason why, after eight centuries, his name and memory are still alive in our collective imagination, fascinating, inspiring and guiding us in our times of deep changes - or in the words of Pope Francis, who took his name from the saint, in a radical shift in time. We then discover that Saint Francis uniquely adapted to the changes in his own time, embodying a surprising template of adaptation and resilience. His message, passed on for generations, shows the way to overcome our own trials, teaching us to walk the thin line between traditional wisdom and new ideas, between the importance of preserving the past and the need to face the future in faith and hope.

Former lecturer in Ecclesiology, of Ordained Ministry and Systematic Theology and later rector of the Theological University of Northern Italy, Turin Campus, Roberto Repole was president of ATI (Italian Theological Association) from 2011 to 2019. Since 19 February 2022 he has been the archbishop of Turin and bishop of Susa. Domenico Agasso works as coordinator of the "Vatican Insider", is the author of several books and the editor of Pope Francis book Dio e il mondo che verrà[God and the world to come]



## YOU ARE LOVED God is not mad at you Paolo Curtaz

To this day, the vast majority of people, including believers, see religion as a sort of protocol on how to "behave"; a set of moral rules, a (tedious, limiting) track we must follow, and that, somehow, God is out to punish us. Otherwise, why would bad things happen and why are prayers never answered? Curtaz knows full well what this feels like, having had to cope with major health issues and now living with a pain that has become a constant in his life. In his new book, Curtaz shows us that it is precisely in our darkest moments, when we struggle to keep the faith, that we discover that God is not out to punish us but loves us, and that the Christian faith is not just a question of righteousness but of falling in love. There is a God, and he is in love. With his uniquely engaging and unsanctimonious style, Curtaz guides us to a rediscovery of the Gospel, encouraging us once again to ponder the truth of the Christian message, stripping it of false beliefs and biases that obscure its purest meaning.

Born in Aosta in 1965, Paolo Curtaz is a theologian and writer. He shares his studies and his meditations on the Holy Word with the thousands of people, both believers and non-believers, he meets every day at lectures, on pilgrimages, on the Internet, on social networks and webinars. He has published over fifty books, translated in six different languages. He is acknowledged as one of the few religious teachers that can satisfy the yearning for meaning of contemporary times

#### STRONGER THAN DEATH IS LOVE Starting again after the loss of a child Bernardo Gianni, Loredana Blasi

Most languages don't have a word to define a parent who has lost a child. The loss of a child is so frightening and unnatural we cannot even conceive as possible, let alone giving it a name. It is a hurt like no other, a wound that never heals. Yet, amazingly, human beings find a way to survive it. And to start living again. Yet we cannot save ourselves on our own, especially from an abyss as unfathomable as this... This was what Loredana Blasi learned when she lost her Tommaso. She realized the only people who could lead her out of the darkness were those who had been through the very same hell. And she decided, along with Bernardo Gianni, a monk and the abbot of San Miniato al Monte, Florence, the abbey where Loredana's son was buried, to create a meeting place and support group for parents "orphaned" of their children. In this book the voices of Bernardo and Loredana weave an enlightening dialogue between a mother and her spiritual counselor, aiming to reach all people who are experiencing the same loss. So they don't feel alone, and discover it is still possible to keep living and be saved by love, which is stronger than death.

Bernardo Gianni was born in Florence in 1968. An Olivetan monk of the Benedictine order and a major figure in the Florentine spiritual and cultural scene, he is the abbot of San Miniato al Monte where he has been living since 1996. In 2019 he was chosen by Pope Francis as preacher for the spiritual exercises of Lent.

Loredana Blasi, (1957) lives in Florence. In 2008, four years after the loss of her child, she founded the association La Stanza Accanto [The next room], welcoming and supporting parents who have lost a child and helping them to live again, as opposed to just surviving.

The development of new technologies has multiplied questions on critical issues. What ethical approach can we adopt to have real impact on technology? How do we prevent humankind from becoming technologized instead of technology being humanized? How do we avoid becoming enslaved by "algocracy", i.e., the power of algorithms? How do we respond to the overwhelming power of those who own big data?

#### THE ALGORITHM OF LIFE Ethics and Artificial Intelligence Vincenzo Paglia

The ever-accelerating development of Artificial Intelligence and its benefits and risks are crucial concerns of many and naturally of the Church as well, called to meet the growing need for spiritual guidance in navigating the flood of new data and information. In 2020, in signing the document "Rome Call for A.I. Ethics", the Pontifical Academy for Life led by Msgr. Paglia, along with FAO, IBM, Microsoft, and the Italian Ministry for Innovation, took on the mission of promoting an ethical approach to the use of Artificial Intelligence. A commitment to put AI in the service of humankind and not vice versa. All must not become an aid to the already overwhelming power of tools of oppression from weapons to the innumerable technologies of control and surveillance. Rather, in more useful and profitable fashion, AI should widen the access to still untapped areas of development and progress. Following the lead of Pope Francis, who for years has been speaking of the importance of Al for the future of the Church and humankind, Vincenzo Paglia guides the reader to the discovery of the advancements made and of those still to be addressed to bring about a future in which Artificial Intelligence, ethically applied, will truly have a positive impact on people's lives, even contributing to the attainment of universal peace.

The former bishop and then archbishop of Terni, Vincenzo Paglia is now president of the Pontifical Academy for Life and spiritual counselor for the Community of Sant'Egidio, where he is active for the organization of ecumenical and inter-religious meetings. He is the author of several essays on believers and lay people relations, as well as books on religious themes, the religious ministry and social commitment



The passing of Michela Murgia has been a terrible loss not only for the sociocultural and political landscape but also for those who had met her in person. Marinella Perroni, a theologian and close friend of Murgia's, gingerly walks the thin line between reality and imagination to converse with Michela as they so often did in the past, picking up the thread of discussions left unfinished and that now, through the voices of both women, Marinella and Michela, illuminate the present.

«Conversations (...) with Michela (...) were among my greatest joys in the years of our friendship. Ten years in all - too short a time for all we had to say to each other. Which is why so much was left unsaid, so many topics just briefly mentioned and set aside. Because with Michela you could speak for hours on end, in an interplay of constant references, retrievals and reversals, in bounds and leaps and respites. Sometimes you thought the main thread was a specific topic, others the feeling was that the words themselves were creating the tapestry of thoughts. The loss of her voice has drastically impoverished public discourse. But I can still hear it, though I know all too well the conversations we used to have are no longer possible».

Marinella Perroni was born in Rome on 9 December 1948. After a Doctorate in Philosophy and one in Theology, she became adjunct professor in New Testament at the Pontifical Atheneum of St. Anselm in Rome and served as president of the CTI (Coordination committee of Italian women theologians). She is the author of several scholarly publications on the New Testament.



#### THE MYSTERIES OF THE MONKS Conviviality and prayer Don Anselmo Lipari

## THE RYTHM OF THE SNAIL On living slowly and happily

How often do we find ourselves so "overwhelmed" by duties and deadlines, by the need to be "on the piece," in society, to "be there", that we forget to stop, to take a breath, to give time to ourselves? How often do we neglect the importance of finding the right balance between speed and slowness, of allowing space for silence and boredom, two dimensions of existence so feared and yet so mysteriously necessary and inevitable? In the frenzy of contemporary times, these essential realities, as well as those relating to purity and chastity, now seem to have lost all social value. Yet, in God's plan, everything, even the smallest snail, works according to its own rhythm: a rhythm we must rediscover, listen to and respect in order to live a life of full joy. Father Maurizio Botta, taking his cue from the success of the "Five Steps" catechetical cycle that the young priest has been holding for several years in Rome, reflects with honesty and simplicity, and with his gaze fixed on Sacred Scripture, on the most problematic aspects of existence, inviting everyone to meditate on dimensions of daily life that are often taken for granted, but are fundamental for finding a space of serenity in the difficulties of the present.

Born in Biella in 1975, Maurizio Botta has been a priest since 2006 and exercises his ministry in Rome, after graduating from Bocconi University in Milan. Prefect of the Secular Oratory, for many years he has been a collaborator with the Catechetical Office of the Capitoline Diocese. He has published several books, in which he faces the most problematic issues of faith - and not only - in a clear and direct way, provocative and in dialogue with culture.




