

WOLF'S HABIT Gianluca Gualducci

Bologna. The life of Lupo, born Gianluca Mannari, is punctuated by precious moments when he manages to forget his demanding and stressful job. In the evenings, he seeks refuge at Tonino's tavern, run by a gruff, hundred-kilo-plus host with a sharp wit and an impressively stocked cellar. On Sunday afternoons, he hides away in a game store, reenacting epic battles with dice alongside a group of more or less grown-up teenagers.

One day, however, the police arrest him outside his office—he is the only suspect in the murder of a local entrepreneur, Glauco Bonazzi, found dead on a rainy night, his body desecrated in a small provincial church. Two very different but equally irresistible forces... and two sources of serious trouble.

In his remarkable debut, Gianluca Gualducci introduces himself with a voice that is irreverent, wildly entertaining, yet meticulous in crafting a perfect crime plot. The Wolf's Vice is a novel written in a state of grace—both darkly amusing and deeply unsettling, as it explores the deepest recesses of a killer's soul.



On the shores of Lake Segrino, shrouded in winter fog, a security guard makes a gruesome discovery—a lifeless body floating in the dark, stagnant waters.



He is a tired yet genius investigator—an unstoppable bloodhound when it comes to solving mysteries.In recent weeks, Roberto Riva had been making weekly visits to a mysterious waterfall, a place where followers of Laide Frigerio gather. A charismatic mystic, she claims to be a seer and healer. Mantegazza is convinced that something sinister lies behind Riva's death. A young heir to a vast fortune, with a promising career and a seemingly perfect life, had no reason to take his own life. Determined to uncover the truth, Mantegazza delves into an investigation that will shake the illusion of peace in the province—an illusion that, perhaps, was never real to begin with.

Giovanni Cocco, Born in Como in 1976, he has published *La Caduta* (Nutrimenti, 2013, finalist for the Campiello Prize – Jury Selection), *Il bacio dell'Assunta* (Feltrinelli, 2014), and *La promessa* (Nutrimenti, 2015). He always stays in his seat, observes the world with a dazed look and draws. Giulia, the new teacher, immediately takes a liking to his peculiar character: like her, he seems to carry the weight of a pain. Gradually Teo's drawings begin to become strange, then inexplicable and finally disturbing. In the meantime, Giulia begins to experience strange discomforts. Day after day, instead of getting better, she seems to get worse: she arrives at school late, becomes forgetful and confused, and complains of excruciating pains she has never experienced before. It is a very rare artefact, a bronze representation of the Etruscan hero Telegonus. And when Telegono, with his warrior-like appearance and fiery eyes, inexplicably becomes one of the characters drawn by Teo, Giulia thinks she is going mad.

Inspector Stankovich of the Carabinieri has just been assigned to the precinct of Santa Lucia, in Sardinia. And once again, the transfer is punitive. Because Stankovich is a maverick. He flaunts the rules, detests sycophants, and truly hates having superiors and politicians breathing down his neck. But he's great at his job. Which is why, despite the many skeletons in his closet, he still hasn't been dismissed. Stankovich takes his cases personally - too personally, for a state official - and seeks justice with "unusual" methods. And then there are women, his true weakness. So, from the Northern province of Veneto he has been sent to the most remote and isolated little town in Sardinia. The first time he steps into his new office - a concrete box with prim blue window-shutters and a ridiculous green porch, looking to all the world like a pizzeria he realizes the life of action he loves so much may well have come to an end. But is proven wrong by the body of a young woman found in a cave in the cliffs, half-submerged in water and almost inaccessible from land. She was the daughter of a prominent local entrepreneur, the owner of the trendiest club on Costa Smeralda a man long suspected of strong ties to organized crime but somehow never indicted. Common thinking dictates the young woman's murder must be linked to her father's shady business, but Stankovich never cared much for common thinking, and follows his own line of investigation. A kidnapping from four decades ago and a ramson disappeared in thin air will provide the key to the most unfathomable of solutions

«Never had such a thing happened here». This is the phrase that forensic officer Henning Ohlson hears constantly since his arrival in Liten, a volcanic island wedged in a patch of sea between Sweden and Denmark. Because the murder of a fifteen-year-old girl has nothing to do with the guiet, lonely life on that pile of rocks and woods on which Henning had not set foot for four years. And to which he hoped he would never have to return. In Liten nothing ever happens, and he knows this very well given all the weekends he has spent there trying to bring the woman he loved back to the mainland. The extinct volcano with its perfectly circular lake, so turguoise in colour that it looks drawn, is a beautiful attraction during the summer months. But now that very lake is the scene of a horrendous crime, a girl murdered, tied up to look like a star, and abandoned in the crystal-clear water that has created a thin layer of ice around her. No, nothing like this ever happened on the island. Henning has been called in for his vast experience in forensics, but what he will have to do in Liten will be much more than a few surveys and hundreds of photographs. No one there knows how to conduct a real investigation and he is the only one with experience. He and the reason he hates the island, Annelie Lidhal. Together with his naif assitant Kay Bak, Commissioner Owe Dahlberg, who would rather attend an apple-picking festival than a murder investigation, and Malin, a restless teenager and aspiring influencer, they will try to unravel the first chapter of what seems to be the beginning of a nightmare.

Suddenly, Liten has found itself besieged by tourists. The case of the three girls found murdered in the volcanic lake has drawn crowds of people to the remote island and its dark charms. The life of the islanders, not used to the spotlight, is disrupted. Malin Dahlberg, the daughter of the chief of police, has turned into an Internet sensation. Her reports on the triple homicide and her morbid challenges have become viral, with followers now in the thousands. Until she is blamed with the death of a school mate, Åke, fallen from a cliff while taking an extreme video in what appears as an attempt to emulate her. Malin is certain Åke's death was no accident. It was murder. Yet she herself becomes the target of the investigation. Because Malin had a motive - she hated Åke with a vengeance. So now she must try and exonerate herself. But her behavior - unpredictable, contradictory - makes it harder and harder for people to believe her.

The island of Liten has fallen into disgrace. After the media chaos of the previous year, the regular tourists, resigned to the idea that they had lost their peaceful retreat, abandoned it. Even the morbid curiosity of new visitors soon faded. The news of a young woman's disappearance—who never returned home but apparently never left the island either—thus takes a back seat. The Malmö police close the case as a voluntary disappearance, while online speculation suggests it is nothing more than a pathetic attempt to bring Liten back into the spotlight. Owe, Annelie, and Kaj find themselves investigating without any help. Stepping in are the Anderssons, the island's most influential family, eager to "wash away the shame" of having a murderer among them. However, the clues that emerge suggest a real kidnapping...



Thus, a fierce battle is born: the two women reach into each other's dowries, trunks brimming with treasures and long-buried secrets. Patrizia Rinaldi, a master of genre fiction, crafts a historical novel with a fairy-tale allure, set in a Campanian fief at the turn of a lesserknown century. A story that teaches how love is an untamable force—one that can dismantle hierarchies of power and plunge entire kingdoms into chaos.

Patrizia Rinaldi was born in Naples in 1960. With a degree in philosophy and a specialization in playwriting, she is the author of the successful crime series Blanca, published by Edizioni e/o, and the Signora series, published by Rizzoli. Since 2010, she has been involved in literary projects at the Nisida Juvenile Detention Center. *Il Corredo* marks her first, deeply personal venture into historical fiction.

Considered one of the sharpest satirical cartoonists around, he has been awarded the Forte dei Marmi International Prize for Political Satire twice.

He currently lives in Rome, where he is sometimes seen wandering around with a bad-tempered dog.
