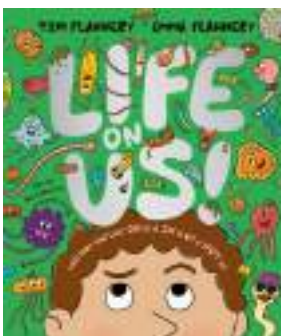
Tim Flannery

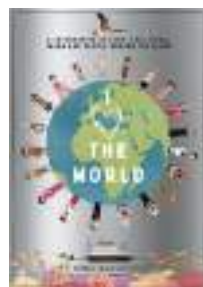

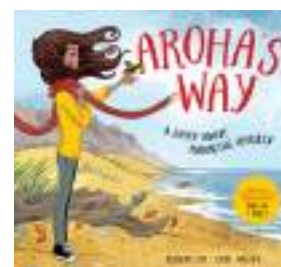

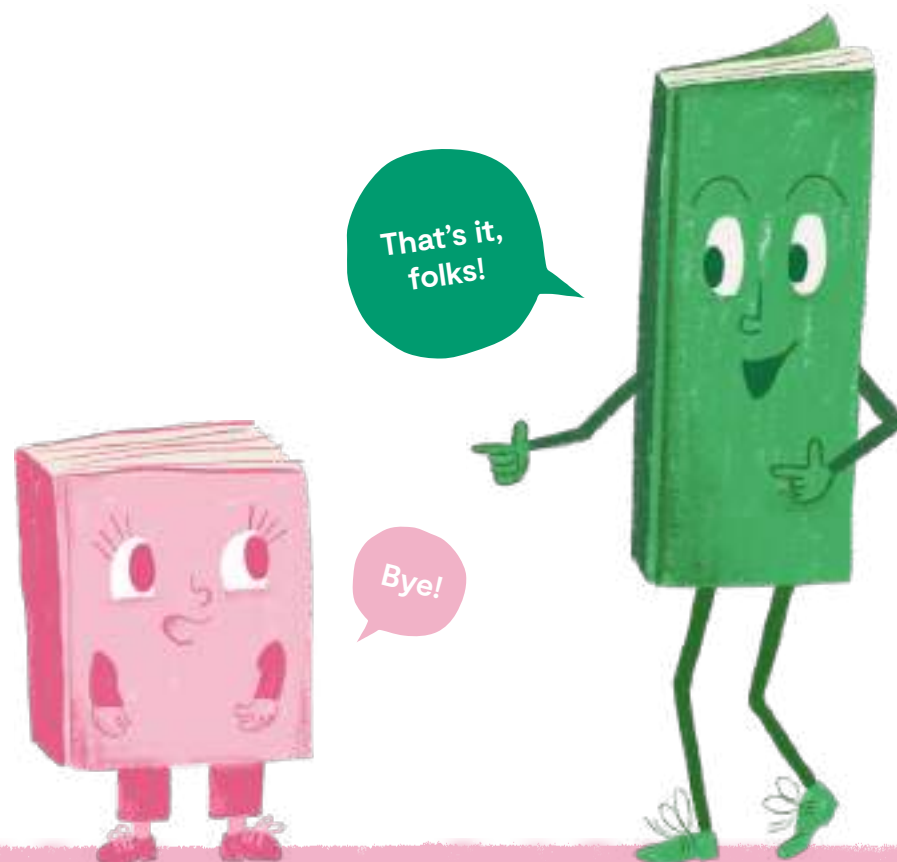
