In his historical essay *A Man of Few Words*, Carlo Greppi told the story of Lorenzo Perrone, a poor and almost illiterate mason from Piedmont who lived outside the barbed wire of Auschwitz III-Monowitz. Every day for six months he brought Primo Levi a tin of soup, helping him survive the camp's starvation, and even risked his own life so Levi could communicate with his family. From hell itself, an extraordinary friendship was born—one that endured beyond the war and deserves to be shared with younger readers.


A book in the spirit of Rodari that invites the very youngest readers to think about the words we use and their incredible power.
