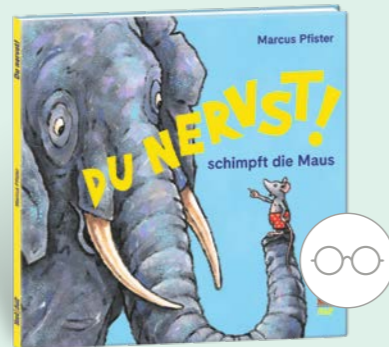

We round off our list with a new book by **Marcus Pfister**, who looks at friendships and how to deal with bad moods.

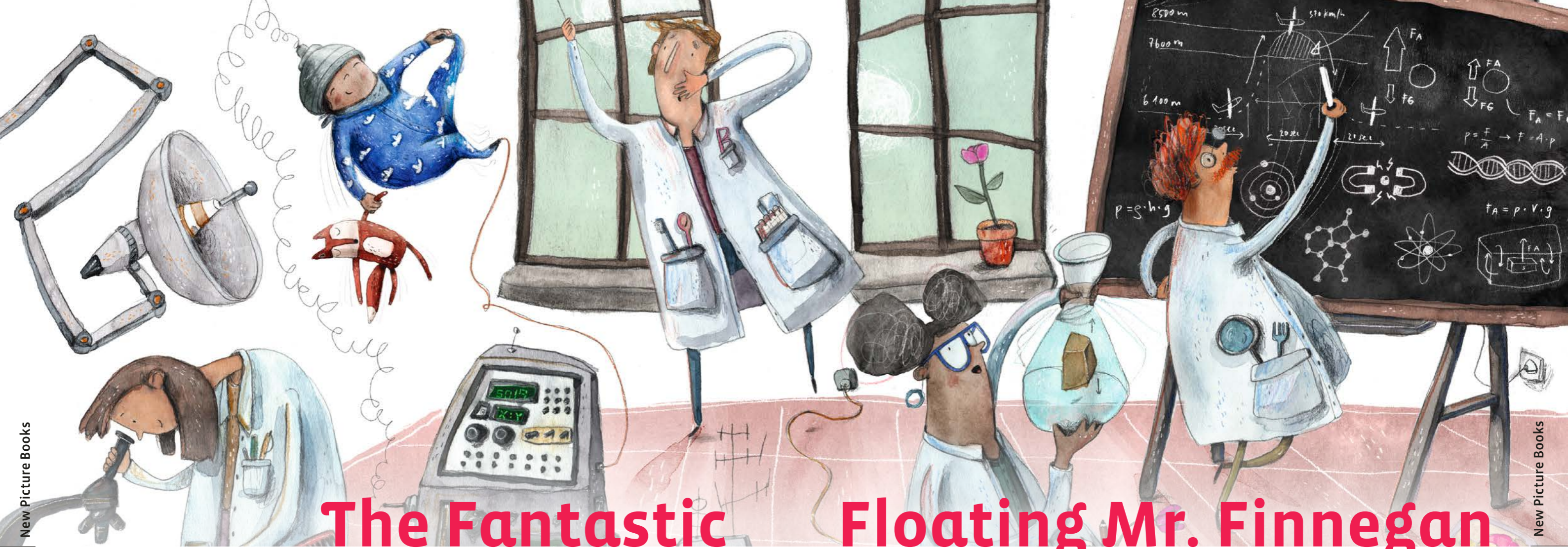

Jacob and Wilhelm Grimm
were born in Hanau, Germany, in 1785 and 1786, respectively, and are considered the founders of German linguistics and literary studies. The Brothers Grimm collected fairy tales, which until then had mostly been passed on orally, and captured them in writing for the first time as a collection. In 2005, Grimms' Fairy Tales became part of the UNESCO Cultural World Heritage.
